

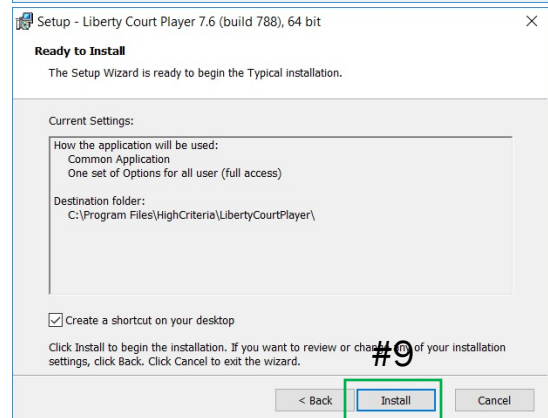
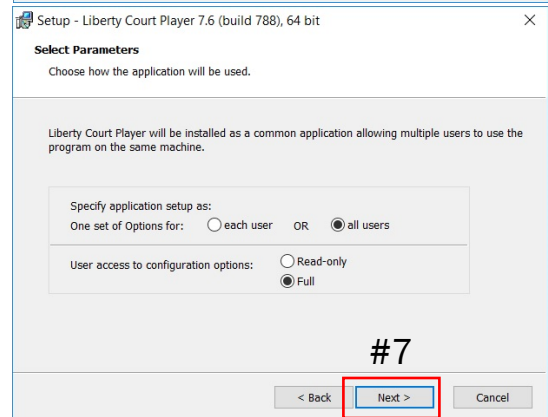
## Installing the Liberty Player and Loading Liberty Recorded Audio

To listen to the digitally recorded audio you first need to download and install the Liberty Player software located at the JCG Technologies, Inc. website.

Follow these steps to install the Liberty Court Player:

*If you're upgrading from a 32Bit version to 64Bit, you will want to export your settings under Tools/Export Configuration Options. Once the upgrade is complete, import your settings by selecting Tools/Import Configuration Options.*

1. Open **Internet Explorer** or your default browser and browse to <http://www.jcgtechnologies.com>
2. Once on the JCG Technologies Support site, under JCG News, click on **FREE Liberty Court Player** to begin the download. *Note: Be sure to select the correct bit version (32Bit or 64Bit). If you're not sure, choose 32Bit.*
3. If you receive a Security Warning, click **Run**. If you get a 'Signature' warning, right-click and choose **Run Anyway**.
4. When the download is complete, Select **RUN**
5. At the Welcome window, Select **NEXT**
6. On the License Agreement screen, *Accept the License Agreement*. Click **Next**
7. On the Select Parameters screen, select All Users and click **Next**.
8. On the Select Installer Folder screen, leave all the defaults and click **Next**.
9. On the Ready to Install screen, click **Install**.
10. When the setup is complete, click **Finish**.





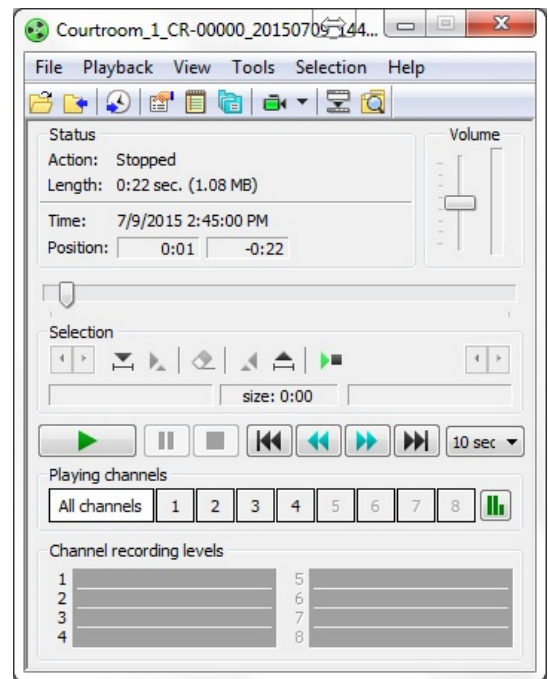
## Loading and Playing a Liberty Recording




Follow these steps to successfully start the Liberty Player and load and play your recording:

1. From the Windows desktop, **OPEN** (Double-Click) the Liberty Court Player icon.



2. The program starts, displaying an empty Player window.
3. To locate the recording needed, click on the **OPEN FILE** button  or click **FILE+OPEN** from the Pull-Down Menu in the upper right corner of the screen. The recording is usually located under C:\Liberty Recordings. You can also search for the recording by clicking the **Find in Files** button. 



4. Your recording should now be loaded, click on the **GREEN Play** button  to play the recording.
5. To playback audio/video from a point where you have inserted a **BOOKMARK**, double-click on the **BOOKMARK** and the recording will jump to that time.
6. To Pause the playback, click on the  button.
7. To Stop the playback, click on the  button.
