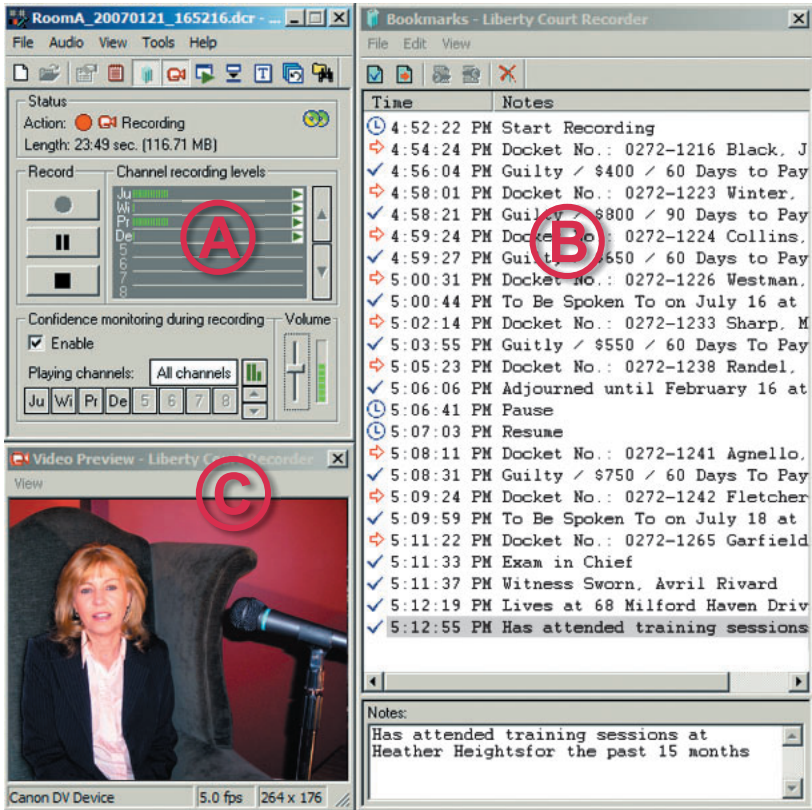

Using Liberty Court Recorder*

Liberty Court Recorder is a licensed program available from High Criteria Inc. Program features include:

- ✓ Ability to record multiple channels and isolate one, or a number of channels for playback
- ✓ Integrated notes that allow instantaneous playback from any point in the audio file
- ✓ Confidence Monitoring allows for monitoring of audio levels in real-time
- ✓ Video capture from any standard video feed
- ✓ Integrated file saves audio, text notes and any video into a single standard file
- ✓ Real-time file save to network, or any removable media including USB drives, flash cards, memory sticks or CDs.



This screen capture shows how a court reporter can use the Liberty Court Recorder to add file notes to a recording, monitor the progress of the recording, and add bookmarks at different points in the recording.



Individual meters display each channels recording level allowing the reporter to see the recording levels in real-time.



Bookmarks with associated time-stamp and text notes, allow for easy identification of individual cases and re-cueing of the audio for instant playback.

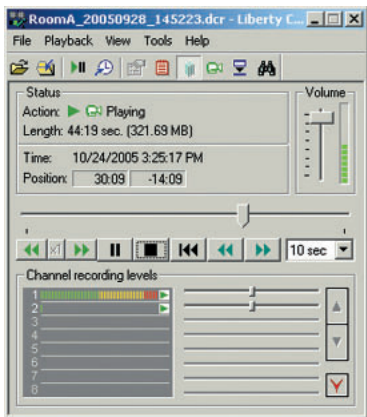


The Liberty Court Recorder supports the capture of video input from various input sources. The video is saved into the same file as the multi-channel audio and associated notes. Captured video may be exported into industry standard formats such as AVI.

*PC Requirements

The recording PC must meet the following minimum specifications:

- Pentium 4 Processor of 1.6 GHz or faster,
- 512 MB Ram or more,
- Available USB port or PCI card slot,
- Windows XP (recommended).



Using the Liberty Court Player

The Liberty Court Player provides playback facilities for your captured audio files, and it is available at no cost from the LibertyRecording.com web site. The Player runs on any PC with Windows 98 or later and that has standard audio capabilities.

The Player lets you select and listen to individual channels in a recording or all of the channels at once. An optional foot pedal for controlling play-back is available and requires a USB interface on the PC.
